ATTENTION Oakwood University Employees:

As we prepare to reopen the University for Fall 2022, please remember that Oakwood University is following COVID-19 protocols created by the CDC.

Please keep in mind the following:

Testing: COVID-19 testing is **no longer required** for Fall 2022 entry to campus. (If you wish to be tested, <u>click here to find a testing location</u>.)

Vaccination: CDC recommends COVID-19 primary series vaccines for everyone ages 6 months and older, and COVID-19 boosters for everyone age 5 years and older, if eligible (Please click here to find a location for vaccinations)

Safety Protocols:

- A well-fitted mask is **mandatory** while in **instructional, residential, and occupational** spaces.
- Masking outdoors is optional. This includes individuals who have been partially or fully vaccinated.
- Continue to maintain a minimum social distance of 3 feet between persons.
- Continue to wash your hands often.

Be aware of typical symptoms of COVID-19, which include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Severe or acute symptoms include:

- Trouble breathing
- Persistent pain or pressure in the chest
- Confusion
- Inability to wake or stay awake
- Bluish lips or face

If you are ill and experience any of the above symptoms, OR if you test positive for COVID-19, please notify your supervisor and HR immediately - hrcovid@oakwood.edu - for instruction. The isolation period is currently 3-5 consecutive days. If you are experiencing OsevereO symptoms which could be life threatening, call 911.
