

The Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act was passed by Congress and signed into law to provide economic relief from COVID-19. One section of the CARES Act established the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) and sent money to schools to use for emergency financial aid grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the pandemic.

CRRSAA Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) II

- The following method(s) were used by Oakwood University to determine which students receive financial assistance and how much they would receive under the HEERF Programs:
- Students information from their FAFSA and other documents provided are reviewed to determine if a student's request meets appropriate qualifications.
- Oakwood is awarding funds ranging from \$350 to \$12,840.
- The actual grant depends on the student's Expected Family Contribution (EFC), expenses, and availability of funds.
